How it Works

Funded by the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act, the We're All In Small Business Grant Program will provide \$2,500 to 30,000 Wisconsin small businesses to assist with the costs of business interruption or for health and safety improvements, wages and salaries, rent, mortgages and inventory. Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible, businesses must:

- be a Wisconsin-based, for-profit business;
- employ 20 or fewer full-time equivalent (FTE) employees, including the owner;
- earn greater than \$0 but less than \$1 million in annual revenues (gross sales and receipts); and
- have started operating prior to Jan. 1, 2020, and have been in business in February 2020.
